Hope for better days by next year. Yet I can't complain, I am fine and can take it. pretty ruff stuff this combat but there is great consolation in it caring for the boys. Don't think they don't appreciate it. I was out in front Xmas distributing Communion to the boys who could not leave for the Xmas Masses.

I don't hear much news from the U. as papers are still slower coming. Assume this short letter. But since I came back the desk is piled high with unanswered letters.

My health is fine and haven't had a sick day over seas. Must be the many prayers said for us and the boys which helps?
