Don't think they don't appreciate it. I was out in front Xmas distributing Communion to the boys who could not leave for the Xmas Masses.

Don't hear much news from the O, as pagers are still slower coming. excuse this short letter. But since I came back the desk is piled high with unanswered letters.

My health is fine and haven't had a sick day ever since. Must be the many prayers said for us and the boys which helps?
