1. Under the provisions of paragraph 4h, A. R. 60-5, each chaplain, whatever his status, will render on this form a monthly report of the following: Duties performed by himself; services by civilian clergymen; any changes in status, duties, and address during the month.
2. The data required by these reports are essential for purposes of administration and record. Reports will be returned for revision in case of serious error or lack of necessary statistics.
3. The report will be typewritten, in duplicate, the original forwarded through military channels to the Chief of Chaplains, and the copy filed at unit headquarters.
4. Every chaplain is privileged to write direct to the Chief of Chaplains for information, guidance, or professional instruction, under paragraph 2a(4), A. R. 60-5.
5. If no religious services were held on a particular Sunday, the reason will be stated. The probable cause for notably small attendance will also be given. Copies of programs, photographs, and other matter illustrating the Chaplain's activities may be forwarded with the report.
