Dear Mgr,

Enclosed I am returning your check from Home Missions for Moosehouse etc. The reason for return is very obvious. Since early this month I have been on sort of a excursion or hunting trip - It sure is nice traveling around. As I mentioned in my last letter the demands of overtime, but consoling - As yet I have not said Mass in the evening - altho I have had many peculiar situations - Yesterday - I had what I thought was enough consecrated hosts but from the time I turned around until after Communion time about 60 must have come in or decided on the moment to go to Communion - I almost ran out of hosts until I remembered I was carrying about 60 or more next to my heart - so the situation was saved. Each day finds me in a new place with no definite spot to place the head I must admit I have been rather careless - its nearly three weeks since I have really gone to bed - the most I have removed have been gloves
