

Racial Equality Is Panel Topic

A panel discussion on racial equality will be held at 8 p.m. today at the new school auditorium at Nativity, which will follow a special 7 p.m. Mass.

Members of the panel will be the Rev. James L. LaChapelle, SVD, of Divine Word College in Epworth, whose topic will be "Racism in the Contemporary Church," Thomas Auge, assistant professor of history at Loras College, whose topic will be "A Historical Survey of Racism in America," and Hugh Nocton, a philosophy instructor at Loras College, whose topic will be "What Is Black Power."

Students from the Black Power Movement at Loras College will attend the discussion. Mrs. Ruth Nash, recording secretary of the Dubuque Area Council on Community Relations will be a member of the panel.

A question and answer period will follow the talks, according to Thomas Shea, moderator. The discussion is open to the public.
