Food does arrive and is well received. But the cash is poorly used or lost. The Protestants, I know, do not have a fair disposal of what we have and yet it is they who are buying up hospitals, children's homes, homes for the aged, etc, in Catholic Bavaria, and making converts, which is understandable among a destitute deluded people. I'd really appreciate in some way representing whatever agency of our Church which is in charge of Catholic funds from America. I know of so many good "buys" but have not the money to deal with. I'd be glad to leave the
