D-1 Fr. Fidelis Kaufman rosary donated by his sister-in-law Mrs. Leta Kaufman who had given it to him originally Fr. Fidelis Kaufman was the Loras College assistant Librarian from 1926-1952. This rosary is at least pre. 1930's the rosary crucifix has a relic of St. Fidelis who was born in 1577 he constantly up held the causes of the poor and oppressed people he became a priest in the capuchin order he was soon head of the Capuchins group sent to preach agents the Calvinists and zwinglians in swizer land. It was said that his prayers helped more than his sermons. He was soonkilled for aiding the poor. St. Fidelis was canonized in 1746 fifteen years after his death and he was considered the first martyr of the congregation for the propagation of the faith established in 1622.
