I also take care of the Guerella soldiers attached to our unit. Mestof them are devoit Catholics. Some p ople may thing that these soldiers are ruff and uncultured men but this is farm from the turth. I have Ma hard time keeping up mi supply or rosaries and prayer books to satisfy the demand. Thanks to the Witness, today I received a large box containing hundre ds of old rosaries and prayer books donated by the good people of the Diocese. I thank the good people who so gratiously donated their old rosaries and I assure them my boys both the Americans and the Philipmes will use them to good advantage. It is also edifying to see these men at the front lines with the rosary hanging about their necks. 't is easy to identify a 'atholic wounded man or one initied in action.

News looks good on both fronts. The Japs are having trouble setting up a cabinet. Seems that every time they get one set up our Navy and airforce knocks it down.
