I did not have an opportunity to contact you on the way from Ft Lawton to my new assignment at Hd. XXI Corps at Camp Peck La. The War Dept. decided I have enough rest at Fort Lawton & there was need of some good healthy chaplains on combat duty so they are preparing us for another theatre of operation.

I did read of Ft Hoffmans bad luck. of stepping on a booby trap & resulting in the loss of his foot or so - That will at least assure him of not being killed in action as some of the boys might expect. Poor Bill Mullen while in ~~at~~ Seattle did not like the idea of Alaska & when they shipped him to San Francisco port he expected Hawaii or places south. He landed in a tank force and wound up at Kiska - He may have moved out from there.

I have no other news of note. What kind of a job this is as asst Corp's Chaplain I do not know but
