Dear Monseignor,

Just had a ~~stormy~~ session with Dr. Sanner. He objected ~~very strongly~~ to the write-up in the Witness saying he did not look too old or was not showing his age. We were out the other night and had a steak dinner - real T Bone - I broiled them.

I have been trying to get away long enough to visit the Leper Colony in Molokai. So far I have not succeeded. I'd readily forego that privilege if someone would say "Let's go home". Certainly I would just as soon any day now return to a small parish, ~~and do some real work.~~ not that we don't have enough <sup>work</sup> of it here. I am feeling so adept at throwing up on altar anywhere that when we do return it will be hard not to.

I really enjoyed all the clippings that Dr. Sanner has from the Witness & Telegraph Herald and especially the list of ~~'bunkers'~~ pledged to the Memorial Chapel of Loras. ~~I don't see any Chaplains on it yet.~~

I have not had a chance to see <sup>any</sup> of the ~~Chaplain~~ <sup>Chaplain</sup> ~~keep~~ but will one of these days especially Fr. McEvoy - Give my regards to all
