Dear Msgr. Foley,

Now that the war here is over, and that leap-frogging across France, Germany, and Austria, where we met the Ruskis, we've settled down. We dropped back from Lembach and Steyer, in Austria, to Bavaria for three weeks, just in time to get everyone possible to his Easter duty. I've had three Battalions to care for lately, but had to move on again to this location.

Contrary to the town's name, there isn't a bishop here, but there are many fine ones nearby. The Church here has many young bishops in Germany and Austria, even in the early forties, very providentially, too, for the great work the Church will have to do in the Post War period.
