Dear Monsignor,

The merry-go-round continues. Running between the POW camp and the two American out-missions - the hospital and post chapel.

Camp Carson is practically vacated, except for one regiment and enough troops to keep a camp running. War prisoners are on the increase. We must have about 4,500 now, with about 3,700 working in or out of various branch camps through Colorado and Kansas. I don't suppose there are more than 400 Catholics (American) on the post, excluding the 90th regiment.

A section of Camp Carson is to be reconverted into a POW camp
