

care for 6,700 Catholic souls. That's 6,700
"C" dogtags, but doesn't mean that all are
practical Catholics. We're three Catholic Chap-
lains out of 50 on Post. There are plenty
of places for priests but no priests
to fill them. When Father Leonard left,
he was replaced by a Christian Scientist.

I bought a tabernacle out of Regimental
Fund, so since Monday, we've had the
Blessed Sacrament reserved here in the
chapel. We have the Stations of the Cross
permanently erected, and open our Novena
in Honor of Our Sorrowful Mother Friday
evening after evening Mass. The evening
Mass draws about 15 regularly, with
a grand exception yesterday, on "D" Day,
with 125 men present for Mass and
Benediction.

We depend on the prayers of our
brother priests.
